



CALL FOR 2026 DOCKET PROPOSALS

Submit by Monday, January 5th

**Have a suggested change to the City of Mukilteo Comprehensive Plan?
Think the city should revise our development regulations?
Have a property you want rezoned?
Submit your proposal by January 5, 2026.**

Washington State law allows cities to amend their comprehensive plans once a year. The City of Mukilteo is now accepting submissions for the 2026 Docket. During this time, interested parties may submit proposals to:

- Change the text of the comprehensive plan
- Change the text of the development regulations (Mukilteo Municipal Code)
- Change the comprehensive plan land use map
- Change the zoning map*

**Rezones that do not require a change to the comprehensive plan may be submitted at any time of year.*

To submit a proposal, email the following to planningdept@mukilteowa.gov:

- For all proposals: A written summary of proposal and how it is consistent with the Growth Management Act and the goals, objectives, and policies of the City of Mukilteo.
- For text changes: Show existing vs. proposed text.
- For map changes: Show existing vs. proposed land use designations/zones.

Proposals are reviewed by staff, who provide recommendations to City Council at a public hearing. City Council decides which proposals to move forward onto the final docket. Placement on the final docket does not guarantee approval. Final docket items undergo further analysis by city staff, review by the Planning Commission, public hearings, and consideration for adoption by the City Council. Submitting a proposal is free. If your proposal is selected for the final docket, a formal application and fees will be required.
